Read Luke 22 v 7-24



The Last Supper took place at Passover time. Why did God institute the Passover Festival?
Exodus 12v14

The Passover meal started with ritual washing, followed by prayer, blessing of the wine (4 cups), and breaking of bread. The highlight of the meal was the roast lamb? Why do you think there is no mention of the lamb in the last supper? (Hebrews 10v10)

What does communion mean to you?

How did the disciples react to the events of the Last Supper? Luke 22 v 18; 21; 23 & 24 & 34.

Read Luke 22 v 39-46. What can we learn about Jesus from this passage?

DID YOU KNOW?

The bread and wine would have been present at most meals in New Testament times. There are no complicated preparation instructions and marks a major shift from the very precise instructions (law) given in Leviticus for all aspects of life including religious and everyday life.

THE SACRIFICED LAMB Read Mark 15 v 33- 39.

Jesus, the Son of God shed his blood for the sins of the world. He had been abandoned by His disciples and felt abandoned by His Father. How can we make sure that we don't lose the reality of Jesus' sacrifice for us because we are so familiar with the crucifixion events?

THE RESURRECTED LAMB

The cross was not the end. We worship a resurrected Lamb. Read Revelations 1 v 12-18
What does this passage remind us about the nature of God and Christ's sacrifice?

OUR RESPONSE

How should our lives reflect such a great salvation?

Rom 12 v1-2

Hebrews 12 v 1-3

What other responses could we have?

FOR MORE STUDY

Hebrews Ch 8-11 is worth reading to understand the New Covenant that God enacted with His people.
